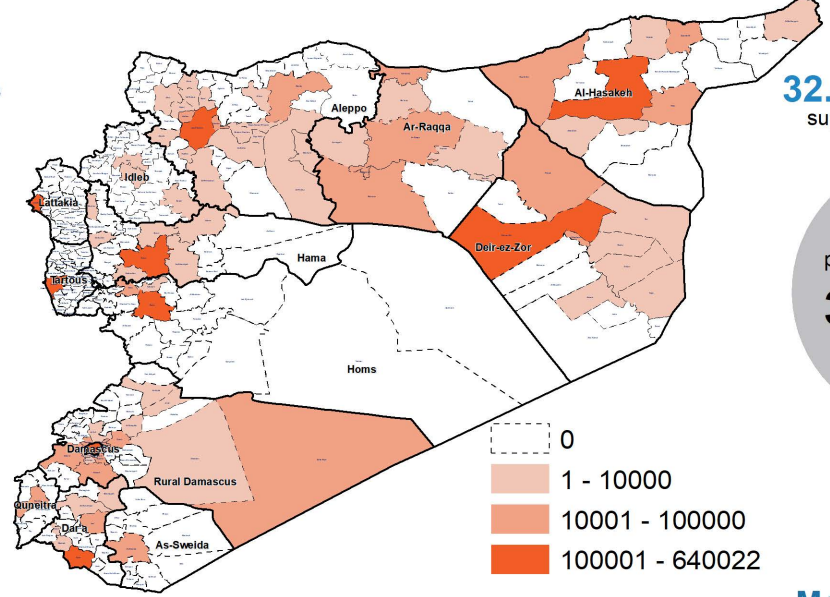
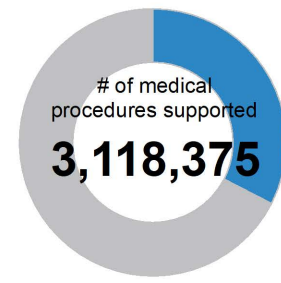


Number of treatment courses provided, at sub district level, Quarter 1 2019

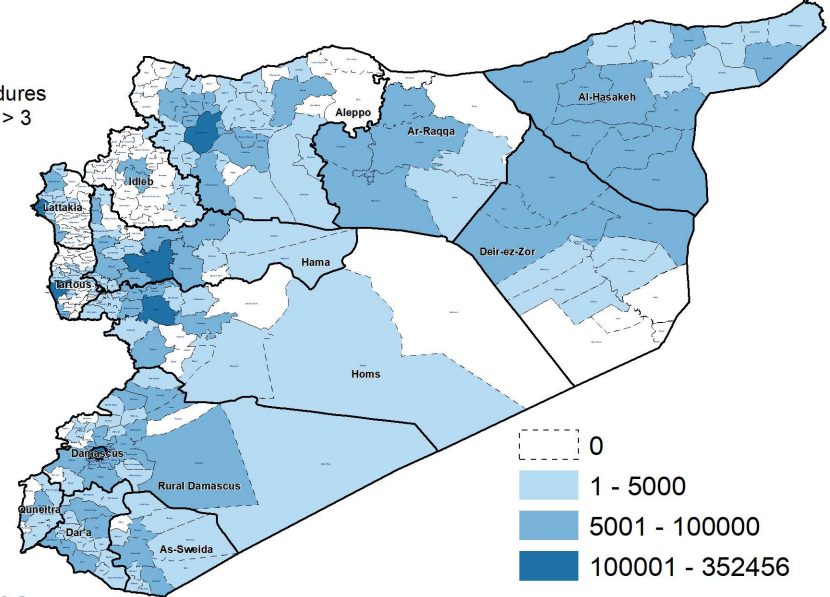

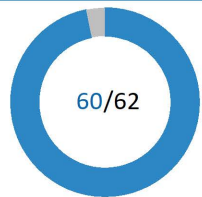


Number of medical procedures supported, at sub district level, Quarter 1 2019

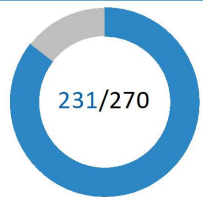

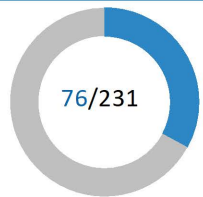

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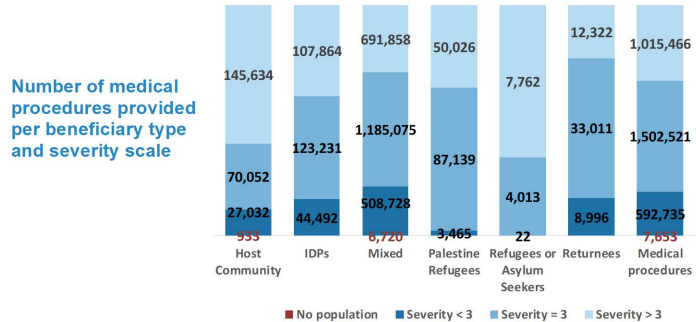
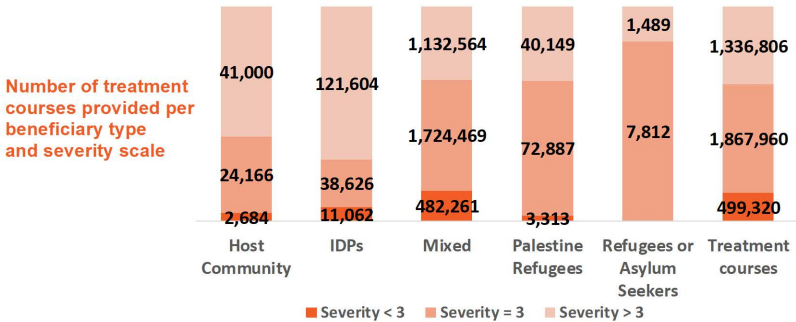
97% of the districts (Mantika) were reached by the health sector partners Quarter 1 2019
