

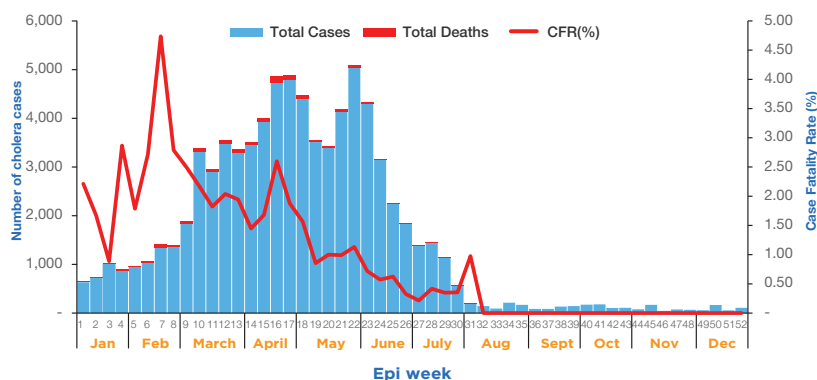
Highlights

- During the month of December 2017, 388 cholera cases, with no death, were reported across the country as compared to 435 cases, with no death, reported in November 2017.
- The cumulative number of cholera cases reported from January to December 2017 is 79 172 including 1 159 associated deaths with a case fatality rate of 1.46 % reported in 52 districts of the country.
- Cholera cases have declined significantly during the month of December 2017 with fewer districts reporting cases as compared to previous months.
- The overall case fatality rate has declined remarkably during the last three months. No death was recorded since August 2017.

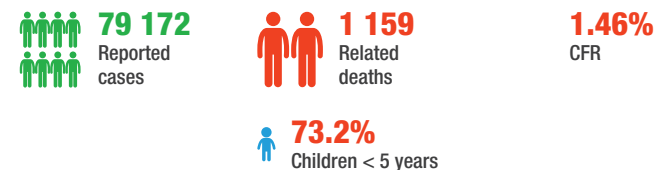

Cumulative key figures, January-December 2017

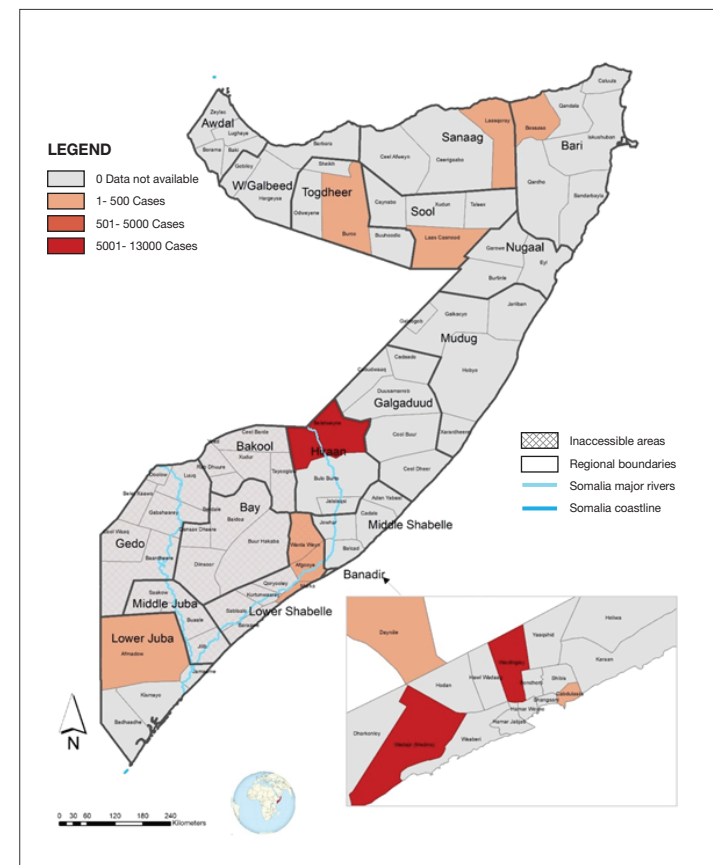


Last 4 weeks key figures, December 2017

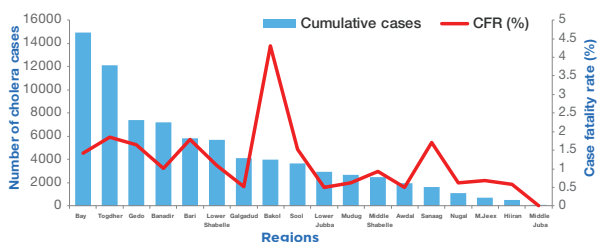
