


Highlights

- During the month of January 2018, a total of 334 cholera cases, with one death, were reported from two regions of the country (Hiraan and Bnadir regions) with the case fatality rate (CFR %) 0.3%.
- These cases in Hiraan region were reported from Beletweyne while cases in Banadir region were reported from 13 different districts. The 47% of the case load was reported from Beletweyne district of Hiraan region. The district reporting highest number of cases from Bnadir region are Hodan (55), Madina (38) and Daynile (30 cases with one death).
- Cholera cases are slowly increasing in number as can be observed from the reported cases trend from start of the reporting month to the end.
- The Cholera treatment centres in Banadir hospital and Beletweyne hospital have been opened to support the management of new cases.
- Rapid Response Teams and community health workers that were trained in Banadir region have been deployed to refer and manage cases in the communities.




