



CHOLERA SITUATION IN SOMALIA June 2018

Highlights

- In June 2018, a total of 1 340 suspected cholera cases including 13 associated deaths were reported from Hiraan, Banadir, Lower Jubba, Lower Shabelle and Middle Shabelle regions; the case fatality rate is 0.97%.
- Since December 2017, a total of 5 496 suspected cholera cases including 40 associated deaths (CFR: 0.72 %) has been reported from five regions. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2 018), Beletweyn (522) and Jowhar (493).
- The number of reported cases during month of June showed a mild decrease as compared to the previous month (1 471), but there is an increase in the number of districts which are reporting the suspected cholera cases and these new districts are Abdilaziz from Bnadir region and Brava and Kurtunwarey from Lower Shabelle.
- A total of 223 stool specimen were collected form 6 Cholera Treatment Centers (CTCs), during January to June 2018, out of which 70 have been confirmed for *Vibrio Cholerae*, serotype Ogawa.


