


### Highlights

- In August 2018, a total of 244 suspected cholera cases including 1 associated death was reported from Hiraaan, Banadir, Lower Jubba, Lower Shabelle and Middle Shabelle regions; the case fatality rate is 0.4%.
- Since December 2017, a total of 6 239 suspected cholera cases including 42 associated deaths (CFR: 0.67 %) has been reported from five regions. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2 291), Jowhar (558) and Hodan (541).
- The number of reported cases during month of August showed a remarkable decrease as compared to the previous month (499). The highest number of cases were reported during the month of May (1 471) and during following months a declining trend observed in the reported cases.
- A total of 261 stool specimen were collected from 6 Cholera Treatment Centers (CTCs), from January to August 2018, out of which 79 have been confirmed for *Vibrio Cholerae*, serotype Ogawa.


