

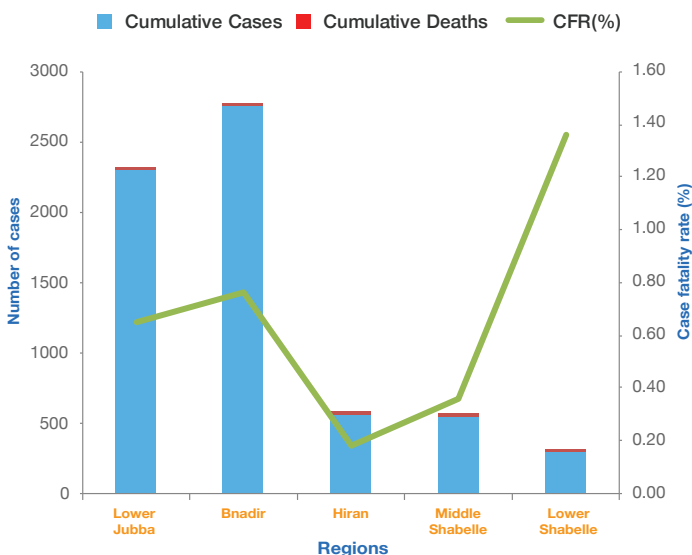
Highlights

- In October 2018, a total of 102 suspected cholera cases and 1 related death was reported from Banadir region.
- Since December 2017, a total of 6 485 suspected cholera cases including 43 related deaths (CFR: 0.66 %) has been reported from five regions. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2 305), Hodan (596) and Jowhar (558).
- The number of reported cases during month of October showed a remarkable decrease as compared to the previous month (144). The highest number of cases were reported during the month of May (1471) and during following months a declining trend observed in the reported cases.
- A total of 296 stool specimen were collected from 6 Cholera Treatment Centers (CTCs), from January to October 2018, out of which 87 have been confirmed for *Vibrio cholerae*, serotype Ogawa.

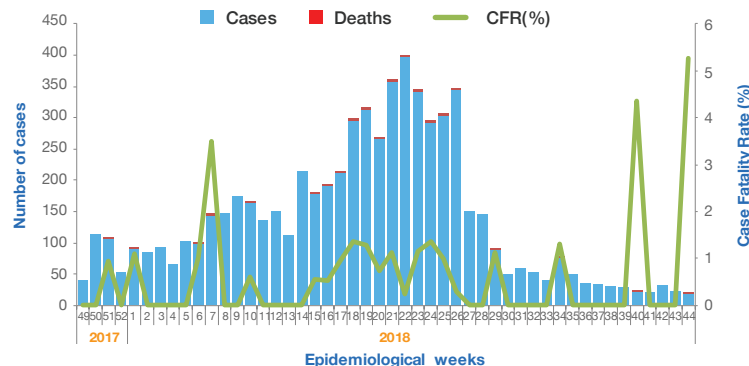

Cholera cases in Somalia, December- 2017 to October – 2018



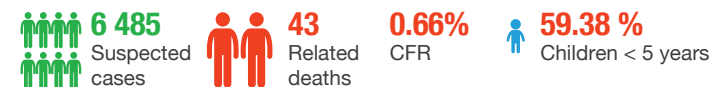

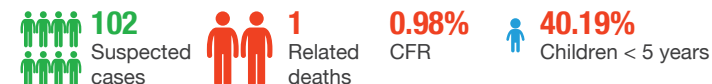
