AN OUTLINE OF CRITERIA FOR SELECTING A FIELD TRAINING AREA TO SUPPORT TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

- I. ACCESSIBLE, SHOULD BE WITHIN REASONABLE DISTANCE
- II. DEMOGRAPHICALLY SUITABLE
 - A. SIZE OF POPULATION
 - B. SOCIAL CHARACTERISTICS, i.e. OCCUPATION, FERTILITY RATE, INCOME, ETC.
 - C. ETHNIC GROUP
- III. GEOGRAPHICALLY APPROPRIATE
- IV. TRADITIONALLY FITTING
- V. RELIGIOUSLY REPRESENTATIVE
- VI. ORGANIZATIONALLY ADEQUATE
 - A. ALL AGENCIES INVOLVED IN PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE SHOULD BE REPRESENTED
 - B. WELL EQUIPPED FACILITIES AND GOOD TRAINERS SHOULD BE AVAILABLE
- VII. SHOULD MEET THE NEEDS OF TRAINERS, AS WELL AS THE COMMUNITY
- VIII.THE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL GAINED BY THE TRAINEE SHOULD BE APPLICABLE
- XI. WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE CRITERIA, INDICES SHOULD BE SET TO MEASURE THE IMPACT OF TRAINING (COLLECTION OF BASE-LINE DATA)
- X. FOLLOW-UP DESIGN TO EVALUATE TRAINEE'S PERFORMANCE AND THEIR PRODUCTIVITY, CONTINUOUSLY (IMPLEMENT THE RESULTS OF THE EVALUATION REGARDING RECOMMENDED CHANGES)
