The working paper on Health Education in the Region is under preparation Contributions for this document have so far been received from Aden, Cyprus, Ethiopia, French Somaliland, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Tunisia, Sudan and the United Arab Republic (Egyptian Province).

A small reference library will also be set up at the site of the Seminar for use by participants.

Subsistence Allowance

For the period of their attendance at the Seminar, those participants nor resident in Teheran will receive a daily subsistence allowance in Iranian ria. equivalent to US \$18. The EMRO Administrative Services Officer will make the first payment of this allowance to participants arriving at the University Clu on the first day of the Seminar. For those participants arriving in Teheran or before 27 October, it will be arranged as far as possible to make an advanc. payment of the allowance at their hotels.

Travel and Hotel Reservations

In view of fact that the opening meeting will be at 0900 hours on 28 October, it is reque that participants arrange to arrive in Teheran by 27 October at the latest in order to facilitate arrangements.
