- Physician because he is the front man who receives all patients first
- 2. Early dectection of psychological cases
- 3.A.Emotional disturbance could be expressed by physical symptoms
  - B. Proper history listening to his patients
  - C. Promote doctors '-patients' relationship
  - D.Proper referral of cases and follow up treatment cases and presenting suitable drugs
  - E.Delegate responsibilities whenver needed
- 4. Graduate training
- Inservice treatment and post-graduate designed programme for 14 days practical and 18-20 hours.
- Theoretically one week psychiatrist present in PHCW. and one week PCO in psychiatric centre.

## Causes :

- 1. General outlook and magnitude of the problem
- 2. Simple symptomathology
- 3. Classification of psychiatric disorder
- 4. Chose the subject on anxiety depression and mal adjustment problem. Psychiatric emergencies and priorities in this area.
- 5. A. No way specified for referral system
  - B. Adequate recording system
  - C. Administrative support and cooperation on all part of mental and general health planners
  - D. Periodical supervision by psychiatrist according to a system agreed upon
  - E. Monitoring programme effectiveness

- F. One single drug at a time with specified dose and limited duration
- G. Central drug store : local drugs.
