PRESENT STATUS OF IMMUNIZATION ACTIVITIES IN THE PATRICIPATING COUNTRIES

This is a brief summary of the information provided by the Ministries of Health of Afghanistan, Democratic Yemen, Egypt, Iraq, and the Sudan. The information itself will be added to the special reference material in the Library for the use of participants during the Seminar.

It is a most welcome indication of gathering momentum of Expended Programme of Immunization in our Region that whereas in the Report of the Damascus Expanded Programme of Immunization Seminar of 1975 it was possible to include only general descriptions of immunization facilities, and amounts of vaccines produced or imported for this seminar, five of the eight participating countries have been able to send ahead information about the numbers of children actually receiving the various vaccines in the 1974 - 1977 period, often by age group and always by 1st 2nd and 3rd dose where applicable. (Actually six countries submitted the information but the pouch from one country was considerably delayed and has not yet arrived). It is possible that some of the other three countries have brought data with them also.

As not all countries are yet presenting the data with the same age breakdowns, a summary table is presented here for the five countries where data was available on 1 December 1977.

Comment. Comparisons cannot be made because of the differing policies and circumstances of the countries. It can be seen that the data are much more helpful now that breakdown by 1st, 2nd and 3rd dose is provided. This enables us to recken (a) the drop-out rate between first and third visit, and (b) the number of children who complete the courses of immunization compared with the number of births in the country. There are I feel two very useful indices. To calculate them year by year tells the Ministry and the responsible officers whether they are gaining or losing ground.

We must eventually refine our tables to give us not only breakdown by 1st 2nd 3rd or booster dose, but also breakdown by age, which for some vaccines such as measles and pertussis and polic is an extremely delicate and important factor in obtaining the greatest effectiveness from them. We can return in detail to this point on Tuesday next.
