TEACHING ACTIVITIES

Under-graduate Teaching

It is focalized mainly in the up-date methods according to the new concepts of the medical education courses and adopted from Dundee Medical Education Centre & includes mainly

- a- Individualised teaching in the tutorials as well as groups problemsolving and assisted by audio-visual aids.
- b- Field Training particularly in a selected rural community, in order that the student should be involved in solving the major rural health problems & to create a comprehensive Family-Doctor relationship.

DEGREE PROGRAMMES & POST-GRADUATE TEACHING

- a- Diploma in Community & Preventive Medicine for one academic year course.
- b- Master Degree in Community & Preventive Medicine for two academic year course.
- c- Integrated post-graduate course in Community Medicine topics for those who are participated in those studying master degree in Paediatrics, Obst & Gynaecology, Tropical Medicine & Chest diseases RESEARCH & SERVICES ACTIVITIES
 - a- A house hold survey is now going on in the rural community of Kafr-Tohormus, Giza Province.
 - b- Operational integrated research studies & mainly based on the epidemiological studies of rickets opthalmias and Diabetes among rural as well as urban communities.

CO-OPERATION & COLLABORATION

- Close co-operation is recently achieved between the Community Medicine Departments belonging to Fahlavi University Shiraz, Khartoum Faculty of Medicine.and Al-Azhar Faculty of Medicine.
