



## Highlights

- During week 52, a total of 126 new cases of cholera and no deaths were reported from 16 districts of Banadir region. No case was reported from other areas
- Since December 2017, a total of 9861 cumulative cases, including 50 deaths (CFR 0.5%), were reported from 3 states of Somalia (Hirshabelle, Jubbaland and South West state) and Banadir region
- Since December 2017 a cumulative attack rate of 224 cases per 100 000 population was reported, with Kismayo (Jubbaland) and Daynile (Banadir) being the most affected districts
- Though the overall case-fatality rate (CFR) was 0.5%, higher rates were observed in Abdilaziz, Daynile, Karan and Kurtunwarey districts exceeding the WHO's threshold of <1% case fatality rate
- Of the 983 stool samples tested for culture since December 2017, 222 samples were tested positive for *Vibrio cholerae* serotype Ogawa
- Culture and sensitivity tests performed at the central public health laboratory in Mogadishu, show that the *Vibrio cholerae*, O1, serotype Ogawa is sensitive to chloramphenicol and tetracycline but resistant to ampicillin and nalidixic acid


Cholera cases, deaths and case-fatality rates by state of

## **Summary statistics**

126 new cases of cholera were reported during week 52, of which 84 (66.6%) were children under 5 years of age

**9 861** cumulative cases including **50** deaths were reported since December 2017 of which **6 019 (61.0%)** were children under **5** years of age and **4 771 (48.3%)** cases were in females

**3 100** cumulative cases of cholera and **4** deaths have been reported in 2019
