

# Highlights:

- ❖ Leishmaniasis increase in Deir Ezzor continues in this week with 467 reported cases.
- ❖ 6 cases of acute paralysis flaccid reported this week from Damascus (2), Deir Ezzor (1), Homs (1), Swaida (1) and Hama (1).


#### Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting

- The overall completeness of reporting was 84%; (1,081 out of total 1280 EWARS sentinel sites). 14 governorates have reported this week.
- Timeliness of reporting was 97%.



### The Morbidity Cases


- Out of a total of 247,408 consultations, 34,642 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 22,907 cases were influenza like illness (66%), 6,715 cases were acute diarrhoea (19%), 419 were acute jaundice syndrome, 571 were severe acute respiratory infection, 23 were suspected measles, 106 were bloody diarrhoea, 60 were suspected meningitis and 6 case of acute flaccid paralysis.
- ❖ Graphs 2 and 3 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 years age groups respectively.</p>





- Acute diarrhoea constitutes (25%) among < 5 and (16%) among  $\ge 5$ , while influenza-like illness constitutes (64%) of the cases among < 5 and (68%) of the cases among  $\ge 5$  years old.
- 49% of the cases were distributed among males. 60% of the cases were distributed among ≥5 age group.
- In total 3,835 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 1,552 cases of leishmaniasis (mostly from Aleppo, Deir Ezzor, and Hama), 202 cases of brucellosis, 172 cases of typhoid, 18 cases of tuberculosis, 69 pertussis, and 148 mumps.

#### The Response

#### Leishmaniasis in Deir Ezzor

- In March, WHO trained 125 healthcare workers in Deir-er-Zor for effective CL case management, in collaboration with MoH and ICRC.
- WHO Procured medicine (pentavalent antimonial compounds) for CL based on the anticipated needs in 2019 for treatment of 40 000 cases in line with the national leishmaniasis programme.
- WHO supported building the capacity for 12 lab technicians at the health district level in Deir Ezzor for laboratory confirmation of leishmaniasis.

Acute flaccid paralysis: Stool samples were collected from AFP cases and sent to the reference lab in Damascus. (105) AFP cases are reported in 2019, (81) discarded, 24 pending. 170 samples were collected from contacts in 2019 up to date annualized NP AFP rate is 5.5. screening and vaccination activities continue for children coming from Dier Ezzor, Raqqa, Idlib and returning from Lebanon and IPV is administered to children under 5 years who missed polio vaccination,
