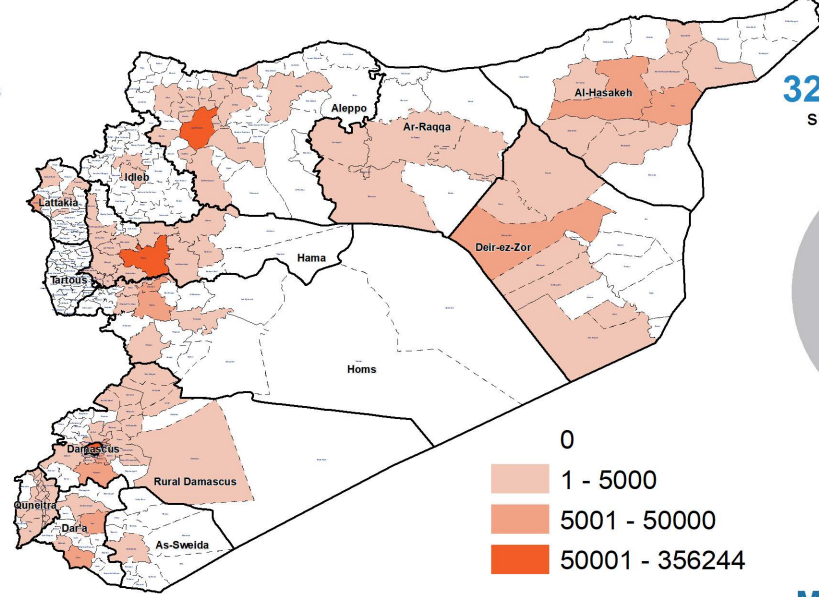
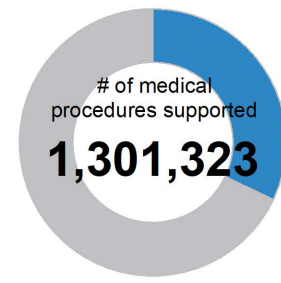


Number of treatment courses provided, at sub district level, December 2019

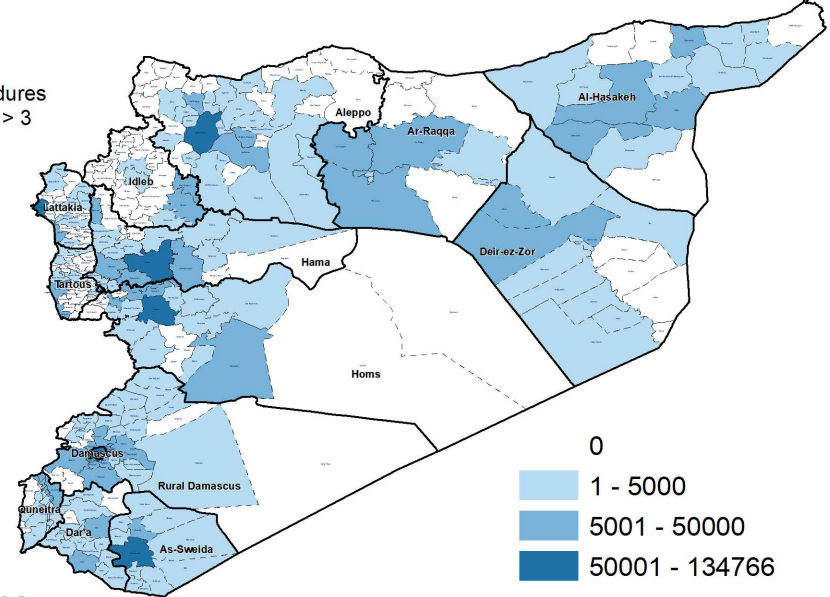

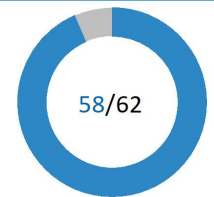


Number of medical procedures supported, at sub district level, December 2019

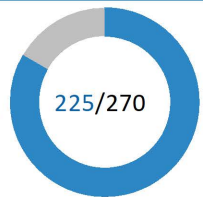

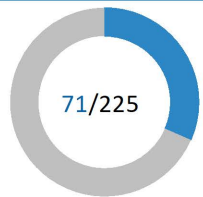

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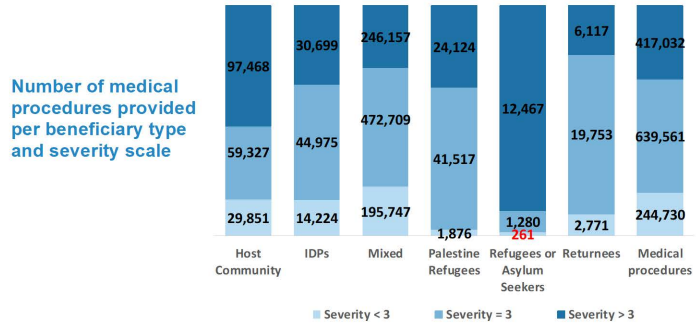
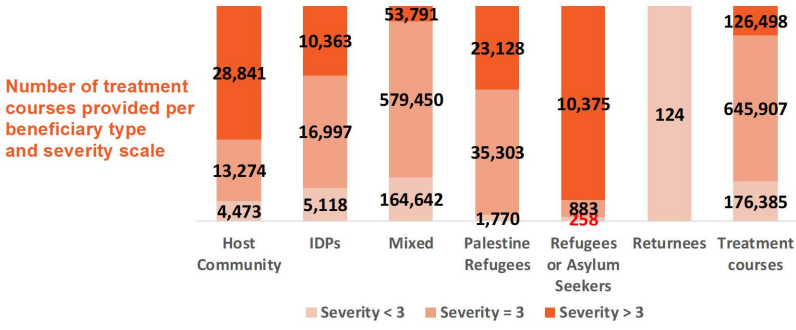
94% of the districts (Mantika) were reached by the health sector partners December 2019
