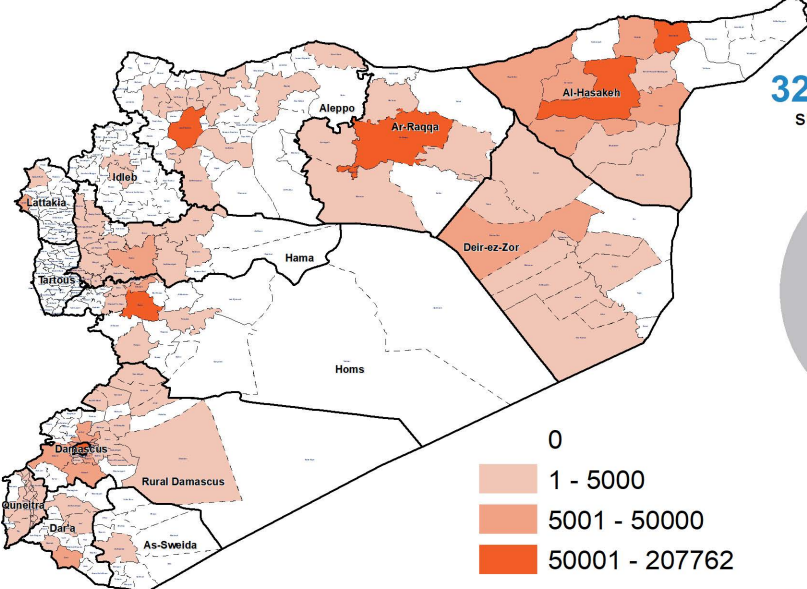
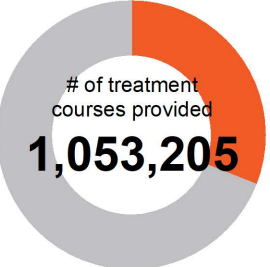


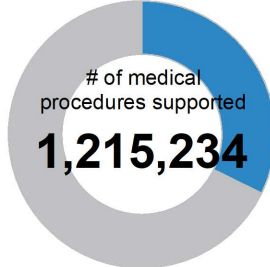
Number of treatment courses provided, at sub district level, October 2019



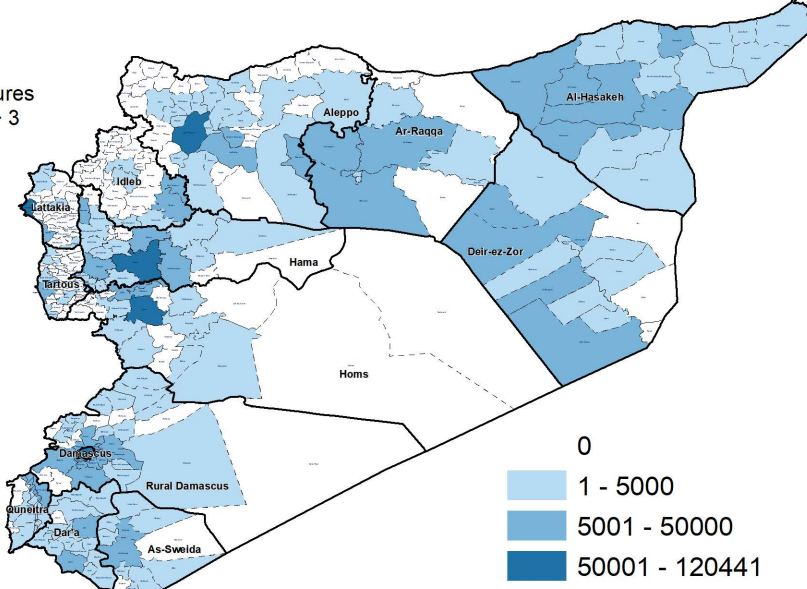

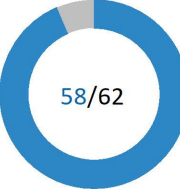

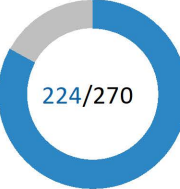

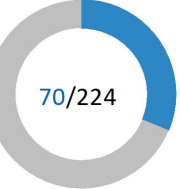

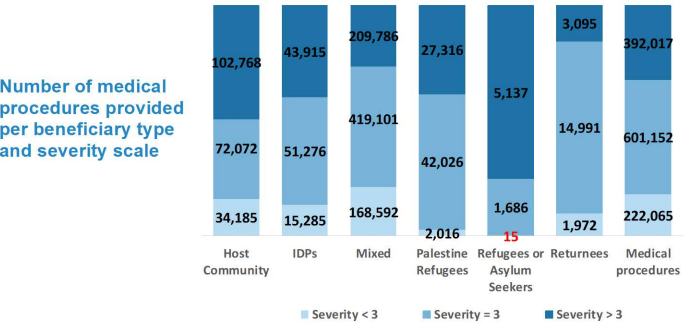
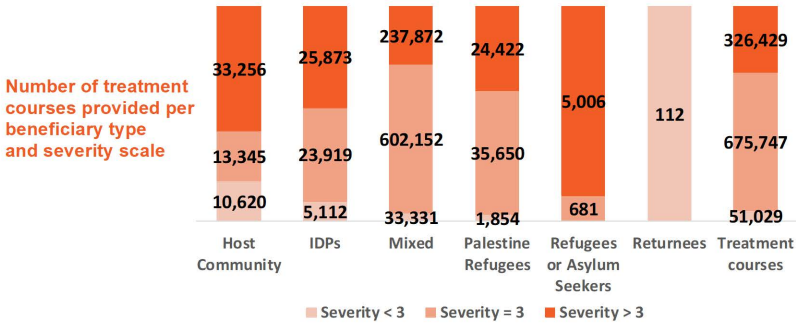
94% of the districts (Mantika) were reached by the health sector partners October 2019
