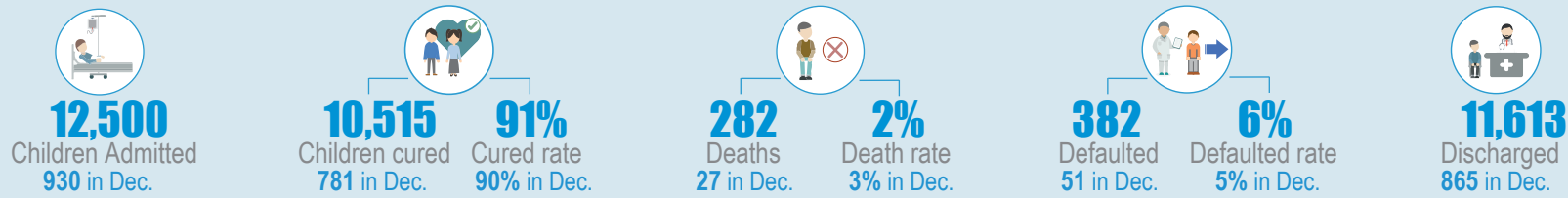


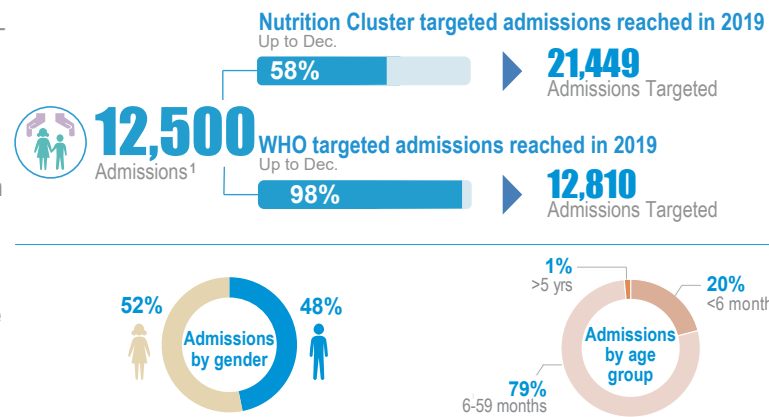
## Key Figures - From January to December 2019



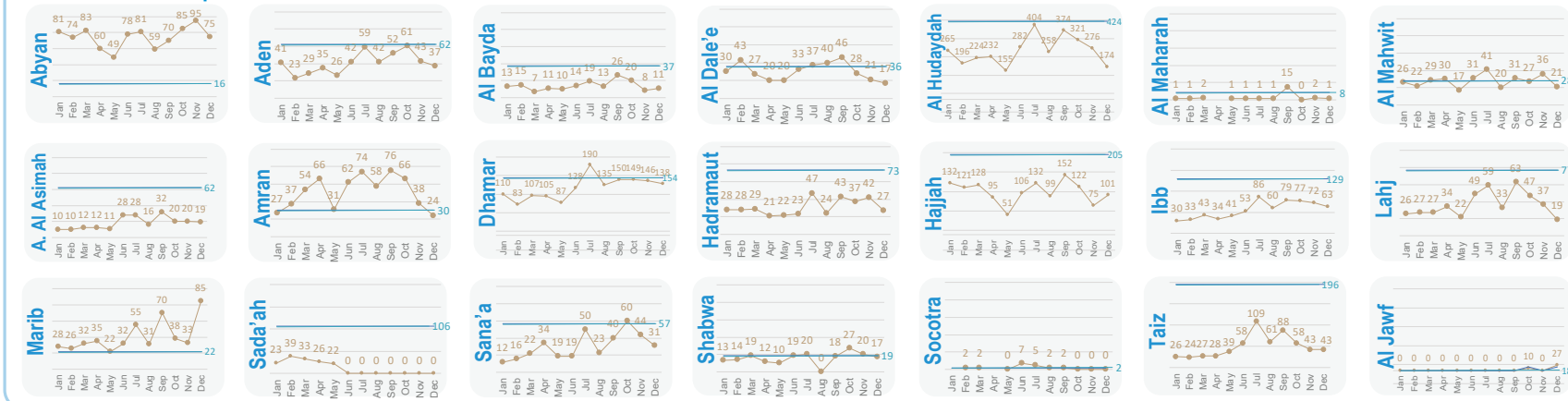
## Service Utilization Jan-December

From January to December **12,500** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **2,524 (20%)** are children under **6 months**. The quality of service is evidenced by the decrease in the default rate and death rate. In December, the cured rate reached 91%, the default rate was 6% and the death rate was only 3%.

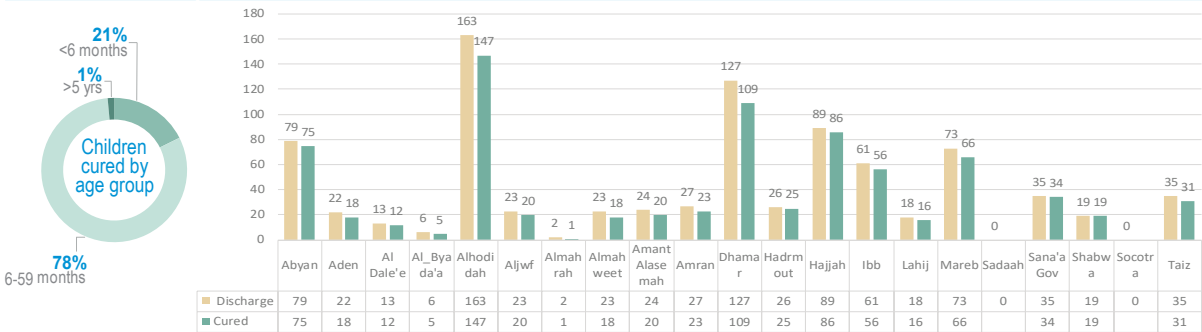
Behind each child, a caregiver was counselled on IYCF best practices, **12,500** caregivers in total. Each caregiver received 10 counselling sessions per hospital stay. In 2019, **12,500** counselling sessions were conducted in **69** TFCs. The increase of equitable access and utilization of quality preventive nutrition services in TFCs, such as IYCF counselling, is evidenced by the decrease in the relapse rate, at **2%** on average per month, throughout the 2019.



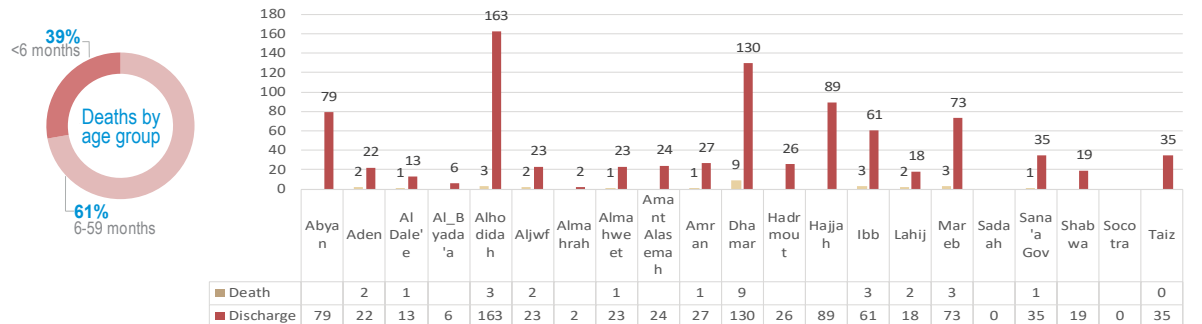
## Service Utilization per Governorate



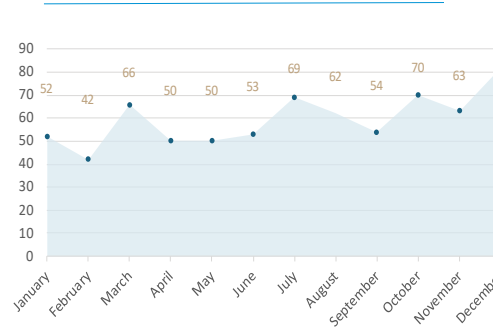
## Cured Children per Governorate in December



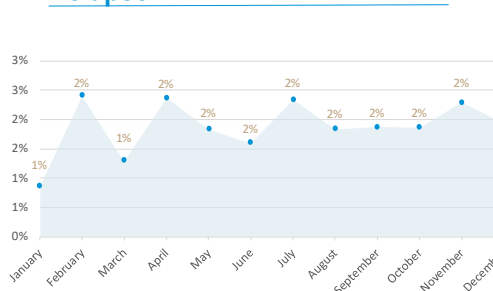
## Deaths per Governorate in December



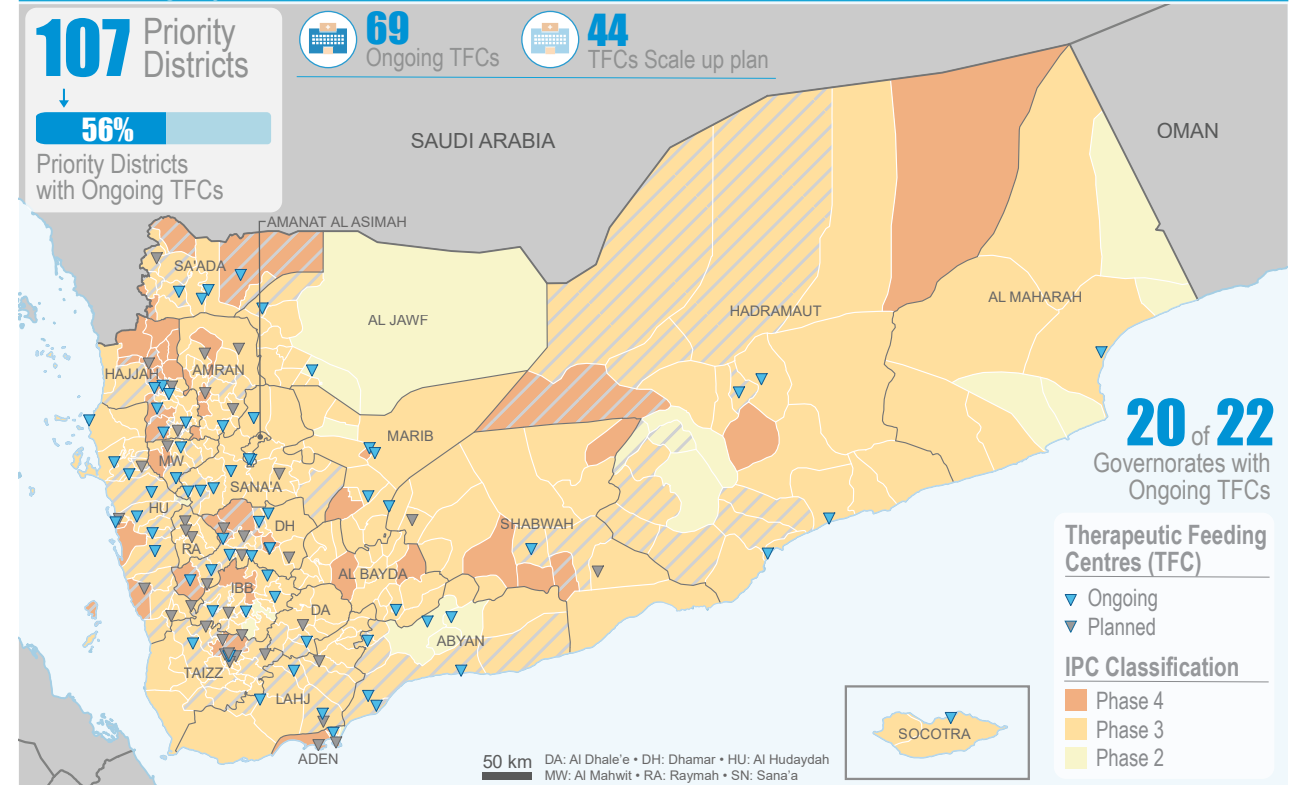

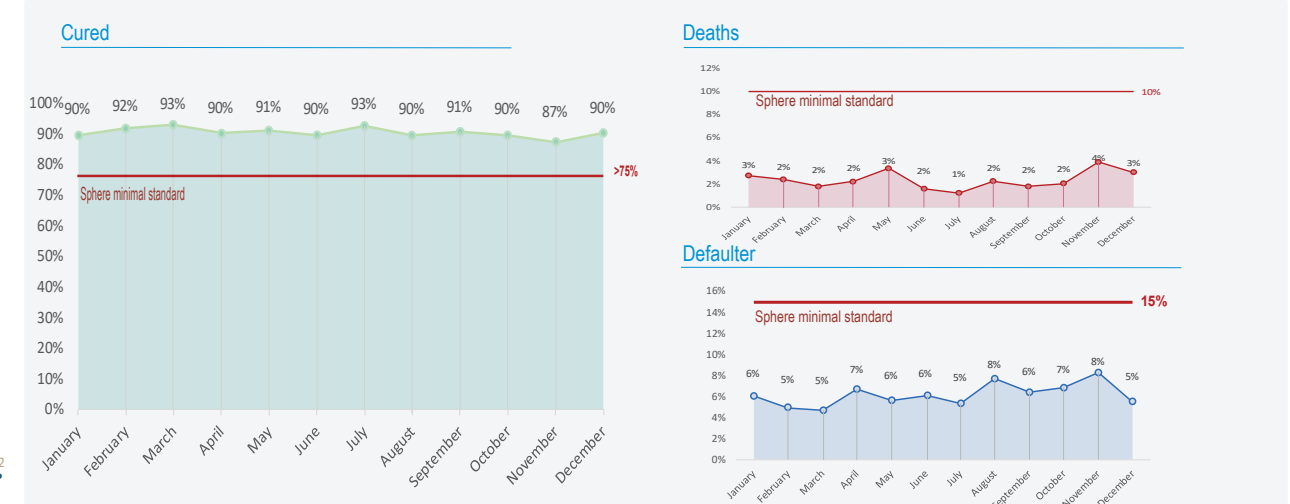
