


## IRAQ: Early Warning Alert and Response Network (EWARN) Snapshot Displacement Crisis in Iraq (June, 2016)

During the period from week 23 to week 26 this year, a total of 137264 consultations were reported by the health facilities covered by the EWARN system with the average of 34 316 patients per week. The consultations were provided to 54% females and 46% males, of which 73% was for five years or above children.

The number of the reporting sites ranged between 110 and 125 during the mentioned period.

A total of 20 alerts were generated during this period, of which 70% were positive cases. These cases were investigated and responded to as required. However, only five alert from (Baghdad, Erbil, Kirkuk) was not verified within 72 hours and the after-investigation result indicated a false alert. Cases of (Suspected Leishmaniasis) made 43% of the total alerts followed by Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) 14%, suspected pertussis 7%, Food poisoning 21% and Suspected Measles 29%.

The proportion of acute respiratory infections (the most common reported disease) was 36% of all the reported diseases followed by skin diseases with 4% and acute diarrhea disease with 9%
