
## Join us in fighting bird flu... Be responsible... Make it possible

Boiled eggs and well cooked poultry are safe to eat


To avoid infection, do not slaughter or defeather birds at home Leave it to a professional who wears protective equipment

To prevent spread of disease, do not shoot migrating birds






To avoid disease do not buy live birds



If you are working closely with birds and have flu-like symptoms, go to hospital immediately



do not raise poultry on rooftops



Wash your hands with soap and water to avoid infection



To dispose of dead birds, bury them in a deep hole or pour water them in a aeep noise or pour water and chlorine on them and put them in the rubbish in sturdy bags
