

CHOLERA SITUATION IN SOMALIA June 2020

Highlights

- In June 2020, a total of 909 suspected cholera cases and 4 related deaths were reported from Banadir, Hiran, Lower Shabelle and Bay regions with CFR 0.44%.
- From December 2017 to June 2020, a total of 14 520 suspected cholera cases including 76 related deaths (CFR: 0.52%) were reported from seven regions, namely Banadir, Bay, Gedo, Hiran, Lower Jubba, Middle Shabelle and Lower Shabelle. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2 305, 15.87%), Hodan (1 736, 11.96%) and Daynile (1 692, 11.65%).
- During the year 2020 a total of 26 deaths have been reported from Daynile (6), Beletweyn (5), Madina (5), Baidoa (3), Jowhar (2), Warta Nabada (2), Jalalaqsi (1), Dharkeynley (1) and Hodan (1), districts of Hiran, Middle Shabelle, Banadir and Bay regions.
- This cholera outbreak is a continuation of the outbreak that started in December 2017 but there was a gap in the reporting of the cases in the first seven weeks of 2019 due to closure of the main cholera treatment center in Banadir. The center reopened in late February 2019 to manage the suspected cholera cases and has since been reporting cases.
- A total of 482 samples tested at the central public health laboratories since January 2020, out of which 163 have been confirmed as cholera-positive by culture.




