


MERS SITUATION UPDATE

September 2020

Highlights


- At the end of September 2020, a total of 2562 laboratory-confirmed cases of Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS), including 881 associated deaths (case-fatality rate: 34.39%) were reported globally; the majority of these cases were reported from Saudi Arabia (2163 cases, including 803 related deaths with a case-fatality rate of 37.12%).
- During the month of September, no cases were reported.
- The demographic and epidemiological characteristics of reported cases, when compared during the same corresponding period of 2015 to 2020, do not show any significant difference or change.
- The age group 50-59 years continues to be at the highest risk for acquiring infection of primary cases. The age group 30-39 years is most at risk for secondary cases. The number of deaths is higher in the age group 50-59 years for primary cases and 70-79 years for secondary cases.




