


MERS SITUATION UPDATE November 2020

Highlights


- At the end of November 2020, a total of 2563 laboratory-confirmed cases of Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS), including 881 associated deaths (case-fatality rate: 34.39%) were reported globally; the majority of these cases were reported from Saudi Arabia (2163 cases, including 803 related deaths with a case-fatality rate of 37.12%).
- During the month of November, one laboratory-confirmed case of MERS was reported from Saudi Arabia. The reported case was a primary case and not linked to any clusters. The reported case was male, national and not a healthcare worker.
- The demographic and epidemiological characteristics of reported cases, when compared during the same corresponding period of 2015 to 2020, do not show any significant difference or change.
- The age group 50–59 years continues to be at the highest risk for acquiring infection of primary cases. The age group 30-39 years is most at risk for secondary cases. The number of deaths is higher in the age group 50–59 years for primary cases and 70–79 years for secondary cases.




Distribution of MERS reported cases from EMR

by week of onset, 2012-2020






