# **CHOLERA SITUATION IN SOMALIA**

JANUARY 2021



#### **Highlights**

- In January 2021, a total of 342 suspected cholera cases and 2 related deaths were reported from Banadir and Bay regions with a case fatality ratio (CFR) of 0.58%.
- From December 2017 to January 2021, a total of 16 617 suspected cholera cases including 85 related deaths (CFR 0.51%) were reported from seven regions, namely Banadir, Bay, Gedo, Hiran, Lower Jubba, Middle Shabelle and Lower Shabelle. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2305, 13.87%), Daynile (2012, 12.11%) and Hodan (1998, 12.02%).
- Since the start of the year 2021, a total of two deaths have been reported from the two districts of Hamar Jabja and Karaan in Banadir region. This bringings up the total number of deaths reported since December 2017 to 85.
- This cholera outbreak is a continuation of the outbreak that started in December 2017 but there was a gap in the reporting of cases in the first seven weeks of 2019 due to the closure of the main cholera treatment centre in Banadir. The centre reopened in February 2019 to manage the suspected cholera cases and has since been reporting cases.
- A total of 89 stool specimen were collected during 2021. Of which only 35 were laboratory confirmed for Vibrio cholerae, serotype Ogawa.




