CHOLERA SITUATION IN SOMALIA MARCH 2021




Highlights

- In March 2021, a total of 226 suspected cholera cases and one related death was reported from Banadir, Lower Shabelle and Bay regions.
- From December 2017 to March 2021, a total of 17 177 suspected cholera cases including 86 related deaths (CFR 0.5%) were reported from seven regions, namely Banadir, Bay, Gedo, Hiran, Lower Jubba, Middle Shabelle and Lower Shabelle. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2305, 13.4%), Daynile (2083, 12.1%) and Hodan (2080, 12.1%).
- Since the start of the year 2021, a total of three deaths have been reported from the three districts of Hamar Jabja, Daynile and Karaan in Banadir region. This brings the total number of deaths reported since December 2017 to 86.
- This cholera outbreak is a continuation of the outbreak that started in December 2017 but there was a gap in the reporting of cases in the first seven weeks of 2019 due to the closure of the main cholera treatment centre in Banadir. The centre reopened in February 2019 and has since been managing and reporting suspected cholera cases.
- A total of 261 stool specimen were collected since the start of the outbreak, of which only 118 were laboratory confirmed for Vibrio cholerae, serotype Ogawa.




