CHOLERA SITUATION IN SOMALIA APRIL 2021



Highlights

- In April 2021, a total of 417 suspected cholera cases and five related deaths were reported from Banadir, Bay, Lower Shabelle and Middle Shabelle regions.
- From December 2017 to April 2021, a total of 17 594 suspected cholera cases including 91 related deaths (CFR 0.5%) were reported from seven regions, namely Banadir, Bay, Gedo, Hiran, Lower Jubba, Middle Shabelle and Lower Shabelle. The districts with the highest cumulative number of cases are Kismayo (2305, 13.1%), Daynile (2148, 12.2%) and Hodan (2131, 12.1%).
- Since the start of the year 2021, a total of eight deaths have been reported from the five districts of Hamar Jabja, Daynile, Hodan, Adale and Karaan in Banadir and Middle Shabelle regions. This brings the total number of deaths reported since December 2017 to 91.
- This cholera outbreak is a continuation of the outbreak that started in December 2017 but there was a gap in the reporting of cases in the first seven weeks of 2019 due to the closure of the main cholera treatment centre in Banadir. The centre reopened in February 2019 and has since been managing and reporting suspected cholera cases.
- A total of 332 stool specimen were collected since the start of the outbreak, of which only 142 were laboratory confirmed for Vibrio cholerae, serotype Ogawa.


Key figures from the last 4 weeks, April 2021

Cholera cases in Somalia, December 2017 to April 2021




