
# COVID-19 MONTHLY UPDATE 💮 AUGUST 2023



#### Highlights


- In August 2023, a total of 3,675 COVID-19 confirmed cases were reported from 6 Member States of the WHO Eastern Mediterranean Region (EMR). There was an increase of 131% in overall reported confirmed cases compared to the previous month when it was 1,591. The highest number of confirmed cases was reported from Lebanon followed by Afghanistan and the Islamic Republic of Iran.
- During August 2023, a total of 40 COVID-19-related deaths were reported from three Member States in the Region with the Islamic Republic of Iran reporting the highest number of deaths followed by Lebanon and Afghanistan. There was an 82% increase in reported deaths compared to the previous month when it was 22.
- Out of the 22 Member States in the Region, 6 reported updates on COVID-19 confirmed cases and associated deaths in August 2023 while in July 5 Member States reported updates on COVID-19 cases and deaths.
- Since the start of the pandemic, a total of 23,389,299 confirmed COVID-19 cases including 351,408 related deaths at a case-fatality ratio (CFR) of 1.5% were reported from the Region.
- 21 countries have reported one or more new variants of concern (VOC) in the Region: Alpha in 21 countries, Beta in 18 countries, Gamma in 6 countries, Delta in 18 countries and Omicron in 15 countries
- Vaccination continues across the Region. The total number of doses administered so far in the Region is 900,577,081 and the average coverage of fully vaccinated population in the Region is 51%. The United Arab Emirates (98%), Qatar (97%) and Kuwait (77%) has reported the highest number of completed primary series while Libya (18%), Syria (13%), and Yemen (3%) reported the lowest number of in the Region

#### COVID-19 cases and deaths per million population in EMR, 29 January 2020 to 31 August 2023






#### Distribution of weekly COVID-19 tested in EMR, 29 January 2020 to August 2023
