KEY FACTS


- The total number of health workers is 36 809.⁴
- The health workforce is mostly young, with 74% of all health workforce under the age of 45.4
- Shortages are being faced in some specialties.
- Most physicians (83%) and dentists (76%) are males.⁴
- 91% of health workers are employed in the urban areas.⁴
- The health workforce is regulated mainly by the Ministry of Health, which provides lifetime licenses to physicians and dentists and annual re-licensing to all other health professionals.⁴


